

Illiana Council Derby Cars Info Sheet

This info sheet provides important information about ordering Derby Cars (page 1), and Derby Car Kit Construction Rules (page 2).

How do I order Derby Cars?

1. Preferred method is to send an email to our quartermaster Al Hulford at IllianaQTRMaster@sbcglobal.net or AllenHulford@sbcglobal.net
2. If you do not get a response, or don't have access to email you can always call Al Hulford at 815-274-5619.

How much do Derby Cars cost?

1. In Council cars are \$2.50 per kit, plus shipping.
2. Out of Council cars are \$3.00 per kit, plus shipping.
3. Extra wheel kits (4 wheels, 4 washers and 4 screws) are \$1.25 per set, plus shipping.

How are Derby Cars shipped?

1. Cars orders are shipped within two days of receiving the order.
2. Cars are shipped the cheapest way possible unless express shipping is requested. Most cars go through USPS and are delivered within 7 days.
3. Cars can be picked up at Council meetings, or if needed from Al Hulford's home.

Additional Information:

1. Derby cars are on the Illiana Quartermaster Order Form, but the price may have changed since then.
2. Best to order early, we process a lot of orders, so the sooner you know what you need the better for you to get the cars on time. Don't wait to order during the holidays, this will result in delayed delivery.

The Model Car Kit Construction Rules

1. Each person will be allowed to construct one (1) car with the aid and advice of an adult.
2. All cars will be built from this kit and only the parts contained in this one (1) kit.
3. The wheel base, ground clearance, and distance between the wheels (tread) will not be altered.
4. The finished car may **NOT** exceed 3 inches in width. (1 1/2" each way from center)
5. The finished car can **NOT** weigh more than eight (8) ounces. (*Weight limits may vary. Be sure to check with your organization as to the correct weight.*)
6. All weights must be built into the car; no 'glued on' or 'taped on' weights will be permitted.
7. Cars with loose parts due to poor construction methods will be disqualified.
8. Wheels, axles, and body components must be those from this kit. Use of any other materials will result in disqualification.
9. One of the four (4) washers supplied in the kit, should be placed between each wheel and the body to act as a spacer to reduce wheel rub against the body.
10. Decorative accessories are to be formed from the materials provided in the kit. No plastic model parts are permitted. No decals may be used except for the official numbers assigned to each car.
11. The following materials are not included in this kit, but may be used in construction of your car.
 - A. Glue
 - B. Paint or finishing materials.
 - C. Solder, Lead, or other suitable weight materials.
 - D. Wood Filler or Plastic Wood used under these conditions:
 1. It is to be used only as a surface preparation for sanding and finishing.
 2. It may not be used as a molding material to form, mold, or build up a part of the car.
12. Body style is a matter of choice. Be sure to follow rule 3 and 4 and the rules on material usage.
13. If there are any questions, please ask an adult or your group leader.
14. **The Material List:**

1 wood body block (pre drilled)	4 washers
4 plastic wheels	1 lattice strip 1/4" x 1 1/8" x 7"
4 wood screw axles	1 dowel 1/4" x 4"
